The good news is that we are still running the Cattail Regatta this year, however the format will considerably different than past years. Some of the differences include there will be no registration. You will essentially announce your registration on the race course before the start of the first race. We will have a modified Skipper's Meeting OUTSIDE of the club prior to the first race with plenty of social distancing. The club will only be open for limited bathroom use. The races will be run in the river versus out in the Maumee Bay. There will be no congregating, before or after races. This includes awards presentations. We will try to deliver awards personally as people are derigging their boats. Because of the current scare that exists today, there are not a lot of chances to race. That is why we want to give everyone this opportunity, but it must be a FUN and SAFE event, with everyone encouraged to sail in a friendly manner. Face Masks and Social Distancing are strongly encouraged when not on the water. We will have water available and pre-made to-go meals available after racing.

We will still run three races with the format to be included in the Sailing Instructions that will be posted on our website jollyrogersailingclub.com one week prior to the event.

This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescription of the One-Design rules, and the sailing instructions of this regatta.

The Cattail Regatta is open to all One-Design classes with a minimum of three boats per class.

Schedule of Events:

0800 – 1100: Rigging and Launching.
1100: Skipper's Meeting.
1155: First Warning Signal.
1200: Start of First Class, Race 1. Race 2-3 to Follow.

This event will be sailed on a upriver/downriver format with start and finish in the center of the course. Length and number of times around the course will depend on wind conditions and performance capabilities of the Class. We will try for a true upwind start as much as possible.

Scoring will be per the Racing Rules of Sailing..
