SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing. On the water communication will be made via VHF radio, channel 72.

2 ENTRIES

Competitors may enter by delivering a completed entry form and paying **\$30** by check or in cash at the registration table in the clubhouse before 12PM on June 14, 2024.

3 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located next to the white board in the clubhouse.

4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Signals made ashore will be displayed from the Race Committee Boat located at the end of the mooring dock. If a postponement is signaled ashore, the warning signal will be made not less than 30 minutes after AP is lowered.

5 SCHEDULE and CLASS FLAG

A competitors' meeting will be held on Saturday at 12 PM at the clubhouse. The warning signal for the first race on Saturday will be 12:45 PM. Subsequent races will be held as soon as possible after the end of the previous race. Dinner will be served at 6:00 PM.

The warning signal for the first race on Sunday will be 9:00 AM. No race will begin after 11:00 AM. Lunch and awards will be held in the clubhouse at noon.

The class flag will be a white flag with the Interlake Class insignia.

6 COURSE LOCATION

The course will be between the Smothers Road Bridge and Red Bank Harbor.

7 COURSES and MARKS

Placards on the side of the Committee Boat will designate the course.

8 STARTING AND FINISHING LINES

The starting and finishing lines will be between the Race Committee Flag on the Committee Boat and a pin with an orange flag.

9 PROTESTS

Protests shall be delivered to the Regatta Chairman within 30 minutes after the race committee pontoon boat returns to the club dock. The protest time limit and a list of protests received will be posted on the notice board. Hearings will be held as soon as possible after racing.

10 SCORING

The Low Point System of Appendix A of the racing rules will apply with the following modification: if 5 or more races are completed, each boat's worst score will be excluded from her series score. One race constitutes a series.

11 TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded to the top 5 boats.
